Madison & Jefferson County Road Walk Re-Route

Due to changing land ownership between Twin Rivers State Forest in Madison County and the Middle Aucilla Conservation Area in Jefferson County a new series of road walks have been identified to connect Thru-Hikers in between these sections of existing Florida National Scenic Trail. At this time Thru-Hikers are encouraged to use the following route to connect between Twin Rivers State Forest – Mills Creek North Unit and the Middle Aucilla Conservation Area. Future efforts will be made with the Counties, local public and private land owners, and Florida Trail Association volunteers to identify a more permanent solution.

This route is a mix of DOT Right of Way and slow traffic dirt roads with some forest canopy. Resupply and camping opportunities are available at I-10 and SR 53 in Madison.
