

Tiger Bay State Forest

Buncombe Hill Nature Trail

Tiger Bay State Forest is part of a wildlife corridor for the Florida black bear, deer, fox, turkey, hogs and bald eagles. The Buncombe Hill Trail is a loop trail with 22 interpretive points. The trail winds through planted pine forest, oak hammocks and sandy scrub areas.

Hike Mileage: 2 miles

Meeting Time: 9:00 AM

Meeting Location: Buncombe Hill trailhead North end of Indian Lake Rd

Entrance fee: \$2.00 per person, self-pay, at the Indian Lake Recreation Area. Children under 6 can get in free.
